The services include Construction Contract Administration Services for the Canton City Engineering Department.

Contract #1 PID 85299 project consists of Safety improvements at the intersection of 12th St. and Market Ave N. with the addition of turn lanes on Market Ave. Safety improvements along the corridor with modifications to the signals and closed loop system, installation of new sidewalks and curb ramps, reconstruction of curb returns, and sign upgrades. Project will also include resurfacing of 12th St., installation of streetscape elements (lights, brick, trees), bus shelters, and relocation/burying of utilities. The project is funded with federal, state, and local funds.

Contract #2 PID 90361/90268/91592 project consists of work on Mahoning Rd. corridor in Canton from Maple Avenue NE to Harmont Ave. and involves the relocation and burying of utilities, installation of new sidewalks and curbs ramps, reconstruction of curb returns, and sign upgrades. Project will also include resurfacing of Mahoning Rd., installation of streetscape elements (lights, brick, trees), and bus shelters. The project is funded with federal, state, and local funds.

Capable of sampling/testing project related items including LPA required materials documents. Knowledge of DBE, EEO and Prevailing Wage monitoring procedures. Construction Management Association of America Certified Construction Manager (CCM) is preferred.

Anticipate that the selected Consultant authorization to proceed by August 2014.

Requirements for Letters of Interest, Programmatic Selection Process

Instructions for Preparing and Submitting a Letter of Interest

Firms must have prior experience administering construction-engineering work and administering ODOT LPA projects listed in the scope of services. The entire qualification package must not to exceed 20 pages. The City will rank the Consultants in the following areas: the firm's background, experience on similar past projects, past project performance and references, the project team, project technical approach, and general presentation. The Consultant must identify all sub-consultants on the project and describe their role. The qualification package must provide adequate information needed to judge each of the preceding categories. Consultants will be short-listed based on the written information provided in the qualification package. An oral presentation may be required. The City will evaluate and rank responding firms in order of their qualifications based upon Ohio Revised Code, Section 153.65 thru 153.73.

Scope of Services

Work includes Construction Engineering, Project Management, inspection, materials testing and/or documentation of the Work performed by the City's Contractor. The services performed in accordance with the Ohio Department of Transportation, "Construction and Material Specifications" and City of Canton procedures, directives and other requirements. The Consultant will provide services to monitor the construction work on a full or part-time basis and report the city contractor's work and determine whether such work complies with the State's contract requirements to the Local Public Agency/Person in Responsible Charge. The Construction Project Engineer (CPE), appointed by the Consultant, will act upon the behalf of the city for the completion of the contract. Consultant will perform City's duties of reviewing payrolls for compliance with

DBE, EEO and Prevailing Wage requirements.
